At the **94th Annual Farm Show** held in Harrisburg in January, Naylor Wine Cellars earned two Gold Medals for *Essence* and *Topaz* wines. *Nouvelle '09* and *Rapture '07* won Bronze Medals. Stop by any of our locations for a sampling of our award winning wines.

Nouvelle '09 is a semi-dry white wine, made from the Reliance grape and has a fruity nose. It was released in time for the world-wide celebration along with *Nouveau* in November. This wine goes well with spicy food, fresh fruit and great conversation. Remember, *Nouvelle* and *Nouveau* are not to be shelved or cellared. They are made be drunk within 9 months of bottling so hurry in and pick up a bottle or two. You don't want to miss this remarkable award winning wine!

This 11,000 sq. ft. building, which is just a stone's throw from the winery, is where you can find our offices and wine packaging products. The Vineyard Report

2009 was a very difficult year in the vineyard due to excessive rainfall. About three times the average fell in Stewartstown. Not only did this require additional spraying of fungicides to prevent powdery and downy mildews, but also much more shoot and leaf thinning needed to be done to allow for air and sunlight to penetrate the canopy so that better disease control and ripening could be enhanced. These two problems, caused by the excessive rainfall, greatly increased labor costs. However, the *quality* of the 2009 harvest will allow Naylor to produce your favorite wines at a high level for your dining pleasure and health.

The 2010 snowfall in February has somewhat slowed up the pruning of the vines, but so far we have not seen any other problems.

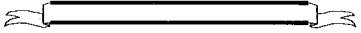
31st Annual Harvest Festival

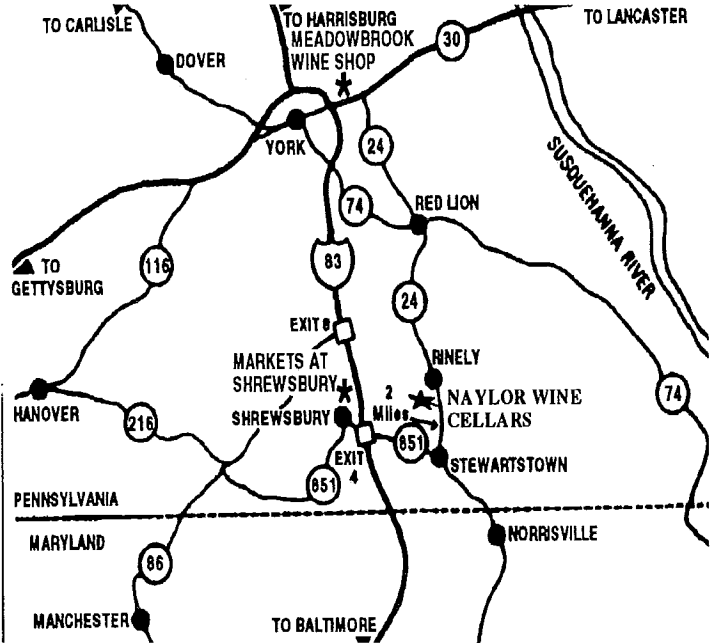
